



**About the Artist**

Chris Maynard combines his background in biology and ecology with his artistic sense and love of birds for a unique art form in a medium largely unexplored.

Maynard applies various methods of design and craft using surgery scissors, forceps, scalpels and magnifiers passed down from his family. Since feathers are three-dimensional and distinctive, Maynard will not paste them flat against a background, but allows their natural shape, color and curvature to enhance the design.

Through his work, Maynard intends to show the integrity of the feather and respect for the bird it comes from. When birds shed or discard their feathers every year, he recycles them in his art. Maynard sources these feathers from an extensive network of private aviaries and ZOOS.
